At present, sentiments are upbeat with harvesting & procurement of crops going on in full swing. Wheat procurement is very strong and has already crossed last year's level. High reservoir levels will aid in Kharif sowing and good cash flow from Rabi crop will further add to liquidity in the hands of the farmers. In the exports market, we have sold 1,007 tractors."
